

## **CGC Tees and Greens Committee**

### **Annual General Meeting Report**

**August 26, 2007**

The Tees and Green committee consists of Bob Bennett, chair, Dave MacMillian, David Hilchey, and Dale Rafuse.

1. We would like to thank the work of John MacDonald and his crew for the excellent job they have done this summer. The wet weather created never ending growing conditions, thus continual mowing and trimming. The golf course is in great condition.
2. The greens were verticut and top dressed 3 times this summer, in addition to the normal fertilizer chemical treatment. We are now trying to deal with moss on some of the greens, by lowering the amount of water we use, on the hot days, to “dry out” the moss.
3. We hope to open # 6 tee in September.
4. In the fall we will do an “underbrushing” project from # 1 Blue Tee to # 3 White tee, to open up the view to the bay.
5. Rounds played is projected to be just over 32,000. That will be 100,000 rounds over the past 3 years.
6. We have been in contact with course architect, Les Furber, for a site visit this fall, to prepare a design for additional tees on #2, # 8, and for a design of a new green for # 13.
