PROCEDURE OF PLAY

- All players must register at pro shop before playing.
- No. 10 tee - No starting on #10 without approval from pro shop. Undue delay between nines will result in loss of turn.

STARTING TIMES

- Starting times are in effect all week.
- Members can book up to three (3) days in advance.
- Green fees (guests) can book two (2) days in advance.
- Pro shop staff reserve the right to add to groups that are not filled. This is to enhance the speed of play.
- If you cannot make your tee time or there are openings in your group, please notify the pro shop.
- Members who do not show up for tee times without notifying the pro shop staff within a reasonable time will be given two verbal warnings by staff. In the event that a member continues failing to give notice of cancellation, they will receive a letter from the Club giving notice of loss of advance booking privileges for a period of one week.

Tee times will be booked starting at times listed below for each month.

MATCH AND HANDICAP

1. All members are responsible for entering their own scores on computer provided in lobby of pro shop building. The Match and Handicap Committee has the right to alter handicaps of members entering competitions who do not have properly maintained handicaps.
2. Club tournaments and matches will be posted in pro shop lobby and/ or locker rooms.
3. Members who enter club tournaments must give the pro shop 24 hours notice if they cannot play. Any member who does not show up for their tee time without giving proper notice may at the discretion of the Match Committee be barred from further Club Tournaments for the balance of the season.

PRO SHOP

1. Golf bags that are stored in the Back Shop will be handled by the Back Shop Staff. Please remove all stored clubs promptly when notified in the late fall. (Chester Golf Club will not be responsible for any clubs left by members over the winter months).
2. All members' golf bags shall be tagged to identify members who have playing privileges.
3. Group bookings will be posted on the website and on a monthly calendar which is available at the Pro Shop.
4. Golf Cars:
Members- \$25 per round plus taxes.
Non-Members- \$30 per round plus taxes.
Golf Car Packages- \$300 for 20 rounds (\$15 per round).
5. Golf Lessons can be arranged through the Pro Shop.
6. The Marshall has been given the authority by the Board of Directors to remove any member or guest for unbecoming conduct, slow play, or failing to maintain the course in a satisfactory manner.

PRIVATE OWNERSHIP OF GOLF CARS

Members of the Chester Golf Club are able to apply to use a private golf car, providing they have a medical reason and a signed doctor's certificate along with an application form from the Pro Shop. There also has to be space available in the car compound for storage. If no space is available the applicant will go on a waiting list. The car has to be inspected and mechanically sound.

Power Car Usage

Private cars are for the use of the designated applicant and their spouse or significant other based on the approval of the Board. Visiting golfers are **not** permitted to use their own cars unless there are no available rental cars.

Insurance

The club will not be responsible for the insurance of the car. The designated member will have to sign a waiver. Owners may be asked to show a copy of their insurance policy to the Pro Shop.

Maintenance

Members are expected to keep their cars in safe and good working order. The club has the right to request to have a cart repaired to its satisfaction. When the repairs are completed to the satisfaction of the club, the car will be allowed to return to the course.

Replacement

Car owners have the right to replace their car at any time. It must meet with the Pro Shop requirements.

Trail Fees

The executive will set trail fees yearly, with the input from the Tees and

Greens Committee.

*The membership should be aware of the car coupon books and the value of them compared to owning and maintaining a private car.

HANDICAP COMMITTEE 2010

- Club Tournament Posters and Matches will be posted in the Pro Shop Lobby and/or Locker Rooms.
- Members who enter Club Tournaments must give the Pro Shop 24 hours notice if they cannot play. Any member who fails to give notice and does not show without giving proper notice may at the discretion of the Match Committee be barred from further Club Tournaments for the balance of the season.

Why Maintain a Handicap?

The golf handicap system was developed to enable players of different skill levels to play golf together on equal footing. We encourage all members to maintain an accurate handicap using the computer provided in the Pro Shop. Doing so will let you track your variations in playing ability and help you to improve. You can then obtain an official handicap index card which is required to play in tournaments and also required to play some courses. If you are unsure as to how to enter scores please ask a member of the Pro Shop Staff for assistance.

Tournament Play

If you plan on entering ANY tournaments, whether at Chester or away, you must maintain an up to date and valid handicap. This requires that you enter ALL scores for rounds played at Chester or away. It has been noted that many members do not keep accurate handicaps - they either do not enter rounds played, enter only high scores (sandbagging) or enter only low scores. We hope that by encouraging this practice, a level playing field for all members entering club events will be achieved, thus prizes will be awarded based solely on merit and fine play.

Monitoring of Entries

The handicap committee will be monitoring the entry of scores throughout the year. Those members who enter tournaments with insufficient valid records may have their handicap adjusted by the committee to reflect the player's ability.

Become a Committee Member

We need more members on the committee. The handicap system can only work if it is understood and monitored. A larger committee means only a small time commitment each. If interested please contact **Mike Brine 275-2392**.

GREENS COMMITTEE

Regulations of play on a day-to-day basis shall be administered by the Professional under the discretion of the Greens Committee.

1. Soft spikes only.
2. Please observe the rules of golf etiquette at all times.
3. Maintenance - Check bulletin board in front of Pro Shop for details.
4. Rakes should be left in sand traps. This enables maintenance staff to mow without undue delay.
5. Please do not play to green when maintenance staff is present unless waved ahead.
6. Please, no littering on course. Use garbage and recycling bins as provided.
7. Please follow all signs with respect to pull carts and power cars. Failure to observe may result in loss of privileges.
8. Only two people are to ride a power car at one time.
9. Each player must have their own set of clubs. Maximum of four players per group unless permission is granted from the Pro Shop with respect to a group booking.
10. Priority on the course: If a group fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than clear hole on the players in front, it should allow the group following to pass.
11. In the event of inclement weather (severe rain, etc.) check Pro Shop to see if any limitations apply regarding power car use, etc.
12. Wednesday mornings are to be designated as Maintenance Day. Early times may be restricted to allow the grounds crew to look after projects that need to be completed.
13. Please repair ball marks, replace divots, and rake bunkers.
14. Practice, other than on practice greens, is restricted to areas designated as such.
15. Handicap golfers may be permitted to approach greens with cars. All cars must be marked with either a flag or sign to indicate this privilege. Please check with the Pro Shop for permission. As well as to obtain rules and regulations that apply.

MEMBERSHIP

Effective May 27, 2009 the following bylaws apply regarding membership in the Chester Golf Club:

1. Membership categories

A. **Senior Permanent:** Permanent resident of the “Chester area.” This area includes the Village of Chester and eastward to the west bank of the East River and westward to the east bank of the Middle River, bounded to the north by Highway 103 and to the south by the Atlantic Ocean. Islands connected to the mainland are included.

Residency must be a minimum of 2 years and those qualified persons whose residency is less than 5 years will be subject to a \$1,500 plus HST initiation fee. To be considered a permanent resident of Chester a prospective member must spend the majority of the year residing in Chester, and the residence must be considered the “Principal Residence” under the Income Tax Act, and/or the Province of Nova Scotia Health Act.

B. **Senior Summer:** A property owner in the Village of Chester, residing in said property a total of at least 4 weeks annually. The Village of Chester for this category extends as far as East Chester Recreation Association (3292 Hwy 3) to the east and westward as far as Robinson’s Corner and Countways Store (4359 Hwy 3). Only a property owner and their spouse (a maximum of 2 persons) are eligible in this summer resident category. “Spouse” includes a common-law spouse or registered domestic partner as defined in the Vital Statistics Act. The residency must have been for a minimum of 2 years and those persons with less than 5 years residency will be subject to a \$1,500 initiation fee (plus HST).

C. **Senior – Spouse:** Spouse or partner of a Chester Golf Club member, living at the same address. “Spouse” includes a common law spouse or registered domestic partner as defined by the Vital Statistics Act.

D. **Intermediate:** This is a courtesy extended by the Club to persons who qualify in the Senior Permanent category and are full-time students in a post secondary institution. These persons must be between the ages of 19 and 25 on April 1, 2010 and proof of student status must be provided. Dues are one-half of the Senior rate.

D. **Junior** (ages 13-18) and **Novice** (ages 6-14): Must be a child of a member or a resident of the Municipality of the District of

Chester. Any Junior who maintains his/her membership for a period of five (5) years and meets the then current residency requirements will be eligible for Intermediate or Senior membership upon reaching the age of 19.

E. **Sick Leave:** A member may at the discretion of the Board of Directors be granted sick leave for a period of one year only, provided further that the member must apply for sick leave before May 1st of the year in which they require leave by application in writing addressed to the Club Secretary. Such letter shall contain a Doctor's Certificate supporting the member's application.

2. The Senior (including Intermediate) membership category shall have a maximum of 850 members. The Junior/Novice category will have a maximum of 220 members. These cap numbers are subject to review by the Chester Golf Club Board of Directors

3. A Waiting List, reflecting the above, will be posted in the pro shop and at the Club website.

4. Payment of Fees

a) Membership fees are due on **March 1st, 2010.**

b) On April 15, 2010 a list of names will be posted at the Club for all member accounts or dues which remain in arrears. As of this date, unpaid fees will be subject to a penalty of \$50.00 plus taxes. **Playing privileges will be suspended for these members until accounts are paid in full.**

c) On May 1st, 2010 delinquent memberships will be cancelled by the Club. Members will have until May 8 to appeal to the Club in writing for reinstatement.

d) Club members who have their membership cancelled for non-payment of fees may not reapply for currently open categories of membership for two years.

LONG RANGE PLANNING COMMITTEE (LRPC) 2010

The Japanese have a word, “kaizen” which means “continuous improvement”. The philosophy is to always be looking to improve. This committee functions to provide ideas and feedback to the executive of the golf course. The main goal is to make upgrades and improvements which require planning and proper use of club capital. I would like to thank Dale Rafuse, who served as chairperson of this committee for the last 3 years, and has become chairperson of the Tees & Greens Committee. We have seen several improvements over the past few years, which include: irrigation system, new tees on #4, 5, 6 & 7, improvements to the cart path, two new practice greens, enlargement of the clubhouse deck, improvements to the club house, etc. These are just a few of the very many improvements we have seen over the last 15 – 20 years.

We should also thank the members of the LRPC for 2009: Philip Chandler, Bob Fraser, Barb Fraughton, Todd Gates, Steve Graham, Dave MacMillan, Ross McGill, Elizabeth Parr-Johnston and Howdy Pew. Two new members have joined for 2010: Malcolm Matthews and Jean Pottie.

Last year a member’s survey was prepared and over 200 responses were received. This information will be used to prioritize our recommendations for the next few years. New tees on #2 & 8 will be open this year. There are plans to build permanent washrooms on the course. Another project under investigation is to build a green on #3, near #6 green. This will serve as another practice area and can be used as a 19th hole if any of the greens on the course need to be repaired or renovated. There are also plans to improve the driving range facility, make upgrades to the cart path system and various tees and greens.

We are very fortunate to have a beautiful place to play golf. By making these continuous improvements each year we will make the playability and enjoyment of the course that much better. This is our club and I would encourage any member to contact me if they have any questions or suggestions.

MEN'S NIGHT

Each week there is a \$3 entry fee with weekly prizes being awarded in 3 divisions. After your round of golf take advantage of both the food and draft beer specials available in the clubhouse.
