1. Existing bylaw: Reference 2.01 Membership, section D

2. Existing bylaw: Reference 2.01 Membership, section F (i) Medical Leave

Revise wording to clarify that medical leaves are not restricted to one time only but rather, they cannot be taken consecutively.

Recommended change:

i) A member may at the discretion of the Club Membership Committee be granted medical leave however, a member cannot apply for medical leave for consecutive years.

3. Existing bylaw: Reference 2.04 Payment of Fees

Membership fees and any Member Account balance are due on April 1st. From April 2nd to April 8th unpaid fees are subject to a late payment penalty of \$50.00 plus applicable taxes or such other amount as determined from time to time by the Board. From April 9th to April 15th unpaid fees are subject to a late payment penalty of \$100.00 plus applicable taxes or such other amount as determined from time to time by the Board. From April 16th to April 22nd unpaid fees are subject to a late payment penalty of \$200.00 plus applicable taxes or such amount as determined from time to time by the Board. From April 23rd to May 1st unpaid fees are subject to a late payment

penalty of \$300.00 plus applicable taxes or such amount as determined from time to time by the Board. Any Senior or Intermediate member who has not paid their Membership Fees and or any outstanding Member Account balance as of close of business day May 1st will have their membership suspended for that entire season. Suspended Members may apply for available Membership opening(s) for the next season and a \$100.00 plus applicable taxes re-application fee will be applied. There is no membership reinstatement appeal process for suspended members.

Recommended change:

Remove the tiered schedule of late payment fees and replace with a flat late fee of \$150 plus HST.
