#### **Tuesday Morning League Overview**

The Tuesday Morning League is open to Female Members of the Chester Golf Club who have a current golf handicap and enjoy weekly competitive play of 9 or 18 holes. League play begins in mid-May and runs through to a closing scramble in late September.

Our dedicated team of volunteers work very hard to organize weekly play - managing communication with players, the tee sheet, and results. A variety of game formats are played during the season and there is a scramble at the end of each month.

The fee to join the league is \$20.00 which funds weekly prizes for the top finishers in both gross and net categories, and other activities such as skills or rule clinics.

League play is a great opportunity to meet new people, hone your skills and enjoy our beautiful course on a regular basis. We encourage participants to retire to the Clubhouse after their round to enjoy social time over refreshments and perhaps lunch.

#### **Joining the League - Payment of Fee**

CGC women members who wish to join the Tuesday Morning League have two payment options:

1. Online payment through the CGC website. This is the PREFERRED method of payment. It can be done when you renew your golf club membership, or at any time.

- Select "Membership, Services & Packages".
- Scroll down to "Backshop & Other".
- Select "Women's Division League Fee". [NOTE: this IS the fee for the Tuesday Morning League]
- This adds \$20.00 to the cart which can be paid online.

2. E-transfer
